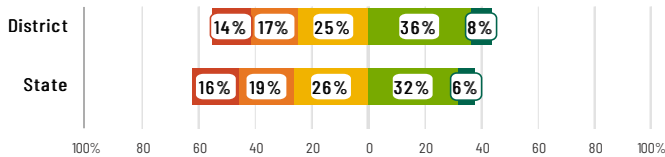

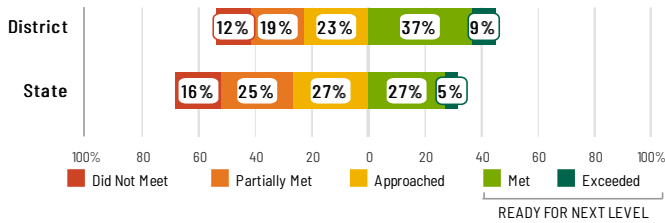
Academic Success

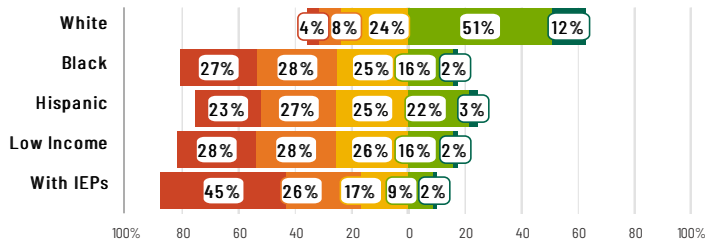

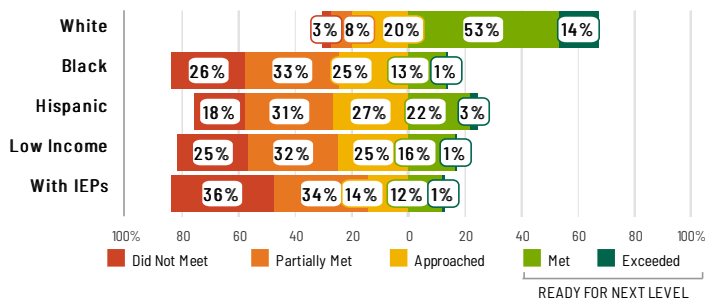

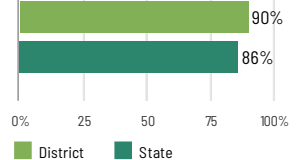
Student Mobility
